Thank you all for attending and thank you to everybody who has supported me and given me this opportunity to look after and direct the Dyfed Junior Boys players moving forward.</p> <p>My aim as County Organiser is to bring the best Junior players from the ages of 14 through to 18 together with the sole emphasis of Team and success on the course. So how do I see or envisage - we can achieve this. Numbers have fallen.</p> <p>Well it starts with you the clubs. I need you to carry on supporting, developing and challenging your Juniors to play at the highest level for them at their home venues. Encouraging improvement is the key with an aim if they want to of course of being selected at County (25 handicap and under).</p> <p>They need not be frightened or weary as to moving onto this level because the County Development and support team will be there along with the other boys who represent us. There will be a new approach build under a team ethos, and a mindset of inclusion.</p> <p>Coaching and development will be offered at County Level, with no Elite & Standard groups as before - ALL players will practice, train and receive coaching together at the decided venues.</p> <p>The wheels are in motion to select and appoint a new coach moving forward for 2024 & onwards - five coaching and development days are planned from March through to July so far. I have requested budgeting for this role and will hopefully be able to put this in place as soon as possible.</p> <p>I want to have a clear strategic approach to our season, so that all players and importantly their families and supporters know what is happening throughout the year well in advance. Also inter - liaison with you the organisers so you will also be able to promote and support players prior to events. Olivia has a spreadsheet / calendar which when completed will be shared with you all. Anyway back to the agenda and may I just say that anything is discussed is open and I welcome your help and comments on any matters notes or any other things we may talk about. Thank you</p>

C.	Safeguarding Forms:	
	<p>OCM noticed how parents were expected to complete a new Parental Consent Form for every Junior Event. OCM proposed that the DGU Safeguarding Form will be utilised for all Dyfed Junior Events, including Club Order of Merit Events. OCM to attend all Junior Events. All in agreement - DGU Safeguarding Form to be used for ALL Junior Events within the County.</p> <p>OCM has created a database of completed Safeguarding Forms. 29 boys have completed the forms.</p> <p>All Club Junior Organisers to share their tee times a week before the event - OCM to inform them who has completed DGU Safeguarding Forms. The West Wales Ladies Golfing Association Safeguarding Officer Mrs Andrea Martin will provide an overview sheet for girls - this overview sheet for the girls will be destroyed after each event.</p> <p>OCM will email the Safeguarding Forms to all Club Junior Organisers.</p>

9	Etiquette, Rules & Competition understanding and support	
	CL discussed the new DGU Junior Guidance. This is in line with the DGU Safeguarding Policy. All agreed with new guidance, CL asked could the guidance be shared with their Juniors before the start of the season. CL reminded clubs to use the lowest gross score for their "Club Junior Championships" or other prestigious events. The lowest gross winner should be the Club Champion , however a nett prize could also be awarded which is normal practice !! Ideally a stroke play (medal round) should be played for such events. This would also help young players prepare and perform under this format and also opens the doors for entry to other championship events"	ALL

	Golf Sixes - Discussion took place - Cardigan and Milford Haven took part in 2022, nothing took place during 2023. Milford Haven had spoken to Wales Golf, they are hoping to reinstate Golf Sixes this year. A question was asked a Junior who belongs to a Dyfed Club but can not play for the County. It was discussed and agreed that because this junior had joined a Glamorgan Club and played for that County. It states in the OOM rules (on DGU website) that he is unable to play for Dyfed. If he has played for another county. CL would ask if the Junior would like to play for Dyfed this year. Speed of play - It was noted that one of the Order of Merit events last year, the juniors did not go out in Handicap Order and they was an issue with speed of play, with some rounds taking 6 hours.
